The armoured arm and leg logo are taken from the Ship's Badge of H.M.S. Bigbury Bay and maintain the naval traditions of the owner, a former member of the Royal Navy.

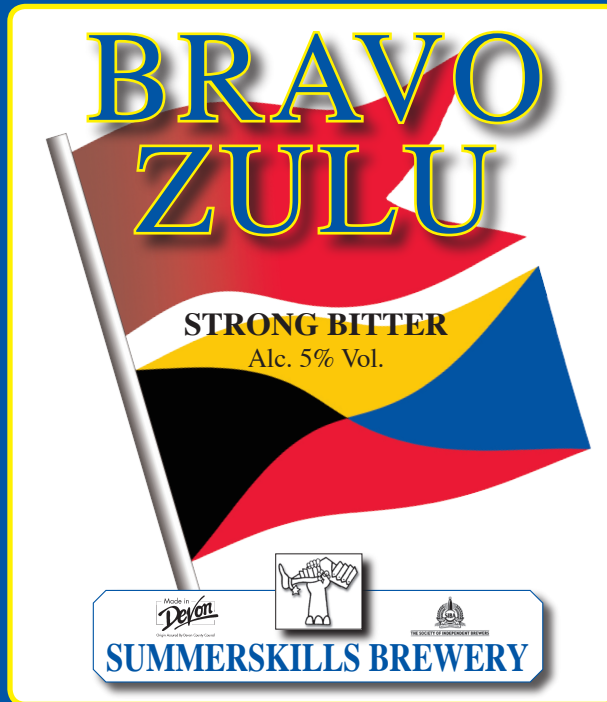
Our whole beer range is made from Devon Malts (from Tuckers Maltings of Newton Abbot), English Hops and Devon water.

Being bottled conditioned, the beer contains live yeast. If left to settle a clear glass of English Beer can be poured. However the yeast has a wonderful flavour of its own and many prefer to disturb the sediment and drink the beer cloudy.

BRAVO ZULU

2008 is the Silver Anniversary of Summerskills Brewery and it is only appropriate for a celebratory beer to be brewed to mark this milestone in the Brewery's history.

Maintaining the Royal Naval connections, the name BRAVO ZULU was chosen as this naval signal means "Well Done" or "Give the recipient a pat on the back" and having achieved the 25 year milestone, it is a well deserved accolade.

Red brown in colour with overtones of malt and hops in the taste, it is made from Devon malted Westminster barley, (grown by Mr. Brian Lethbridge of Stokenham) and English Hops, (the Goldings are grown by Mr. Redman of Stockton, Wors. and the First Gold by Mr. Davies of Dormington, Hereford).
